

## ***Confession GRANTS***

***(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believe, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Romans 4:17***

**Confession:**

**I call those things that are not as though they were. I walk by faith and not by sight and I am not disturbed by the circumstances around me, because I know that God's Word will prevail.**

***That he who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of truth... Isaiah 65:16<sup>a</sup>***

**Confession:**

**I speak blessings over my life, because God has already blessed me with ALL spiritual blessings.**

***Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. Proverbs 18:21***

**Confession:**

**I speak life over my situation, because the words of my mouth have the power to lead me to my God-given victory.**

***If ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. John 15:7***

**Confession:**

**Thank you Lord, because I can abide in You and Your Word abides in me, therefore I can rest assured that you will answer my prayer.**

***For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say, unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Mark 11:23***

**Confession:**

**I speak to this mountain in the mighty Name of Jesus. I don't doubt in my heart, because I believe in His Word. What I say comes to pass.**

***But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach. Romans 10:8***

**Confession:**

**The Word of God is near me. It is in my mouth and in my heart. I speak the Truth over my situation and will not receive any other words spoken over it.**

***Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompense of reward. Hebrews 10:35***

**Confession:**

**I am confident and I know that God will reward me greatly because I have not wavered.**

***But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. 2 Timothy 2:16***

**Confession:**

**I will not speak vainly, but will diligently guard the words of my mouth.**

***Call unto Me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things which thou knowest not. Jeremiah 33:3***

**Confession:**

**Under any circumstance, whatever happens, I will call unto God and He will reveal to me awesome things I have never known before.**

***Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man. Colossians 4:6***

**Confession:**

**I always speak words of life and blessing, not of death and destruction.**

***Seeing then that we have a great High Priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. Hebrews 4:14***

**Confession:**

**Jesus is the High Priest over my confession, therefore I know that He will be faithful to make it come to pass.**

***My son, attend to My words; incline thine ear unto My sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart, for they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Proverbs 4:20-22***

**Confession:**

**I continually confess the Word of God over my life. It never departs from my eyes and gives me godly life and healing.**

***Hear: for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things. Proverbs 8:6***

**Confession:**

**Every time I open my lips I will speak the right and excellent things.**

***So shall My word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: It shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the things whereto I sent it. Isaiah 55:11***

**Confession:**

**God's Word never returns void. It always accomplishes and causes to prosper what it was sent for.**

***For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile. 1 Peter 3:10***

**Confession:**

**I speak the language of silence. Every time my mouth wants to speak any word that contradicts God's Word, I silence it.**

***...This is my comfort in my affliction: for Thy word hath quickened me. Psalm 119:50b***

**Confession:**

**God's Word gives me strength and comfort. It has the power of giving me a new life.**
